NORTHUMBERLAND -- Two artists are teaming up to present a super sized show at the Colborne Art Gallery.

From Aug. 14 to Sept. 26, Anne Wilson will present 'Horizontals and Verticals' while fellow gallery member Terrie MacDonald will offer 'From the Forest Floor'.

Ms. Wilson's show features paintings steeped in the usage of lines and colors.

"The horizontals are all local views, but perhaps not easily recognizable to many. The lake, the marshes and fields, some of which are protected, some quickly vanishing, are all around us. But for how long?" pondered Ms. Wilson in a release. "The verticals are the trees. The old ones, the young ones, the neglected ones and the teenagers. I have tried to show how diverse our countryside is and how we all can appreciate the many facets that Northumberland County can show us."

As the name suggests, Ms. MacDonald's ceramic art is heavily inspired by the forests she has explored in Northumberland County.

"Forest floors are nourishing, life affirming environments, both for the undergrowth they contain and for my spirit when I walk through them," said the artist. "The motifs used to decorate the ceramic work are inspired by observations during my walks in the woods near my home."
